On 14/5/2024, Moot Court competition was organized at Chaman Lal Law College, Landaura. The program was inaugurated by the Chairman of Chaman Lal Law College, Landaura, Mr. Ram Kumar Sharma and Principal Dr. Gireesh Kumar Kapil and Assistant Professors of Chaman Lal College, Dr. Naveen Tyagi, Dr. Suryakant Sharma and Office Head Mr. Dinesh Tyagi by lighting the lamp in front of Saraswati Mata.

In the competition, L.L.B final year and B.A. LL. B final year, Two teams of students were formed. The problem taken in the competition was based on Section 376/34 of the Indian Penal Code in which the prospective advocates from both of defence and prosecution parties and the opposition presented their respective sides. The court found the accused guilty and sentenced him to 10 years imprisonment and a fine of Rs 10,000 and the co-accused was sentenced to seven years imprisonment.

INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO THE GEOPIC LAB AND OIL MUSEUM OF ONGC

On May 3rd WIT Dehradun went for an industrial visit to the GEOPIC lab and Oil museum of ONGC.

This visit was conducted for the final year students of Electrical, Electronics and Communication Eng., and Computer Science Engineering. During this visit along with students, the DIRECTOR of WIT Prof. Dr. Manoj Kumar Panda, Dr. Ashish Bagwari, HoD ECE, Mr. Lochan Bhatt, Assistant Professor, EE, Mr. Divyanshu Chandra, Assistant Professor, CSE, and Mr. Sanjeev Bisht Assistant Professor, ECE were present.

Dr. Vinod, Museum Incharge guided and informed us that the Subir Raha Oil Museum ONGC was inaugurated on August 14, 2005, by ONGC and is situated inside Tel Bhawan, the ONGC headquarters in Dehradun. The museum has various things to make the people understand different sectors of the oil industry and its significant history. It is divided into different sectors, of which the first sector tells us about the geology of the industry. There is a Foucault pendulum, various informative charts, and samples of different types of crude oil in this sector.

Trivia: The Foucault pendulum is a device to shows the Earth's rotation and is named after the French physicist Leon Foucault. It is a popular display in almost all science museums across the world. The museum has many things that give a great representation of the oil industry, its functioning, history, and much more.

Further, the WIT students visited GEOPIC. Here, Dr. Santosh Kumar Sahu, Senior Program Officer, and Dr. Arvind talked about the GEOPIC. The GEOPIC was established in 1987 at Dehradun with a specific mandate of providing solutions to complex E&P problems by in-

tegrating seismic with other geoscientific data. The center has a state-of-the-art infrastructure backed by specialists in the fields of seismic data processing, geoscientific data interpretation, and software development, along with a strong team of hardware engineers. It is the largest computing facility of ONGC and one of the few centers worldwide for integrated processing and interpretation of geoscientific data, from seismic to petrophysical, geological, and reservoir engineering. The ONGC has its own supercomputer named as "Aryabhata-2" to compute the data with fast processing.

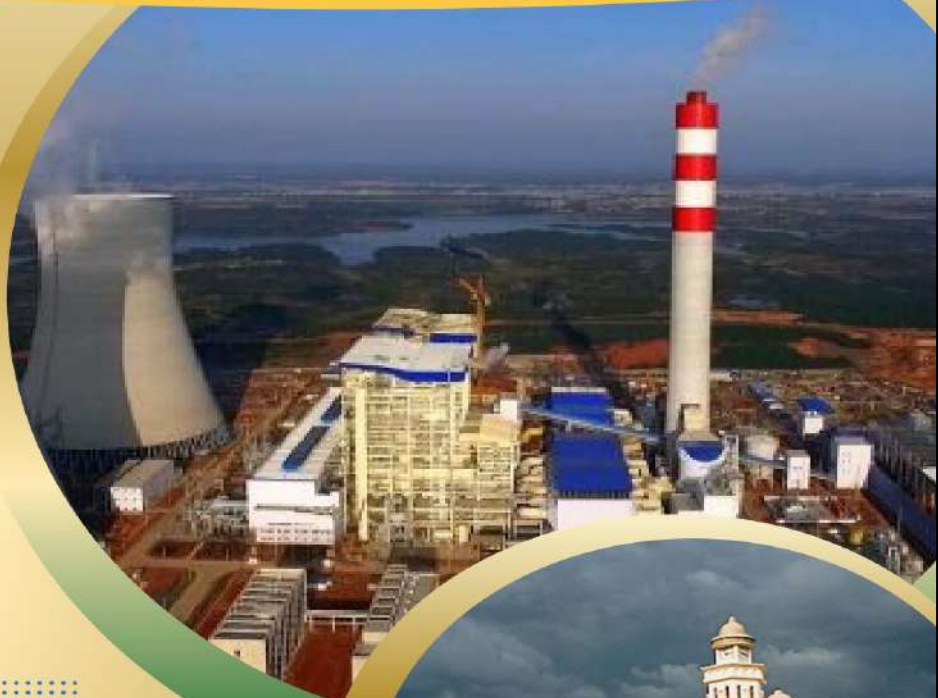

देहरादून। वीर मांगी सिंह भारद्वाज उत्तराखण्ड प्रौद्योगिकी विश्वविद्यालय (यूटीयू) के कुलपति प्रो. ओंकार सिंह ने शुक्रवार दोपहर कई निजी संस्थानों का अीक निरीक्षण किया। इनमें रुड़की क्षेत्र में पतून चाले रुड़की कॉलेज ऑफ फार्मसी (आरसीपी) विद्यार्थी निरीक्षण के लिए एम.फार्मा, एम.फार्मा, रुड़की कॉलेज ऑफ मैनेजमेंट (आरसीएम) में एमबीए और इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ टेक्नोलॉजी रुड़की (आईटीआर) में बी.टेक पाठ्यक्रम संचालित होते हैं। कुलपति डॉ. ओंकार सिंह ने जय इन तीनों संस्थानों में बी.फार्मा व बी.टेक तथा एमबीए पाठ्यक्रम को कक्षाओं का निरीक्षण किया तो कक्षाओं में एक भी छात्र उपस्थित नहीं थे। यह देख कुलपति रोमन रह गये। इस सम्बन्ध में कुलपति ने जब मैनुअल उपस्थिति रजिस्टर का निरीक्षण किया तो रजिस्टर में फरवरी, 2024 के बाद की किसी भी छात्र की उपस्थिति का रिकार्ड अंकित नहीं पाया गया। तीनों संस्थानों के निदेशकों से प्रश्न किया गया कि छात्र-छात्राओं को कक्षाओं में उपस्थिति क्यों नहीं है तो उन्होंने कोई उत्तर नहीं दिया। इन

किसी भी छात्र की उपस्थिति का रिकार्ड अंकित नहीं पाया गया। कुलपति ने मांगा लिखित जवाब: कुलपति ने तीनों संस्थानों की शैक्षणिक व्यवस्था की जांच के बाद कुलपति नाराजगी जताई। छात्रों की उपस्थिति नहीं होने के संबंध में उन्होंने लिखित नोट मांगा। साथ ही चेतावनी दी कि 15 मई 2024 तक कक्षाएं संचालित करने की अंतिम तिथि निर्धारित होने के दृष्टिगत सभी संस्थानों को कक्षाएं संचालित करना अनिवार्य है।
