CULTURAL EVENTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules:

- Each institution can register a maximum of 5 entries per event.
- Participants must carry a valid college/university ID card.
- All performances and entries must adhere to the given time limits.
- The organizing committee holds the right to modify or update events as per the situation.
- Any kind of misconduct, vulgarity, or offensive content will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Decisions of the judges will be final and binding.
- Participants must report 30 minutes before their event starts. Late entries may not be entertained.
- Participants are responsible for their own costumes, props, and required materials.
- Any technical requirements (soundtracks, lighting, instruments, etc.) must be informed to the committee in advance.
- Respect for cultural values and inclusivity is expected from all participants and audience members.

Group Dance (Regional) – 5 min

1. Teams must consist of at least **4 dancers**.
2. Performance should highlight regional folk traditions with modern creative elements.
3. Time limit: **5 minutes** (exceeding the limit will result in negative marking).
4. The use of props is allowed, but **flammable objects, weapons, or hazardous materials** are strictly prohibited.
5. Any inappropriate gestures, vulgarity, or obscenity will lead to disqualification.
6. **Judging criteria:** Choreography, synchronization, energy, theme representation, and overall impact.

Group Dance (Western) – 5 min

1. Teams must have a **minimum of 4 dancers**.
 2. Dance styles can include **hip-hop, jazz, freestyle, contemporary, or other modern forms**.
 3. Time limit: **5 minutes** (negative marking for exceeding).
 4. The use of **props, LED effects, and visual storytelling** is encouraged but must be pre-approved.
 5. Explicit or offensive content will lead to disqualification.
 6. **Judging criteria:** Choreography, synchronization, expressions, energy, and musicality.
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Singing (Solo/Group) – 3 min

1. Participants must bring their own backing track or instrument (if required).
2. Time limit: 3 minutes (negative marking for exceeding).
3. Songs must be within the approved genres (classical, folk, contemporary, Bollywood, fusion, etc.).
4. Explicit lyrics or offensive themes will lead to disqualification.
5. Judging criteria: Vocal quality, stage presence, song interpretation, and overall performance.

Mushaira (Poetry & Shayari) – 3 min

1. Poetry must be original and in Hindi, Urdu
2. Time limit: 3 minutes (exceeding will lead to negative marking).
3. Themes should align with "Virasat & Vikas"—celebrating culture while embracing modern elements.
4. Offensive, plagiarized, or derogatory content will lead to disqualification.
5. Props are allowed but must be non-disruptive.
6. Judging criteria: Content, delivery, emotional impact, and audience engagement.

Drama/Skit Play – 7 min

1. Each team must have a minimum of 3 members.
2. Time limit: 7 minutes (strictly followed).
3. Scripts must be original or adapted, focusing on cultural heritage, social issues, or futuristic themes.
4. No vulgarity, hate speech, or offensive content allowed.
5. Props are allowed but flammable objects, sharp items, or dangerous elements are prohibited.
6. Judging criteria: Acting, script, expressions, message delivery, and audience engagement.

Fusion Instrumental Remix – 4 min

1. Participants must bring their own instruments.
2. Time limit: 4 minutes (negative marking for exceeding).
3. Performances should blend traditional and modern musical elements.
4. Explicit, offensive, or plagiarized music is not allowed.
5. Judging criteria: Creativity, instrumental skills, composition, and stage presence.

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Modeling Competition

Theme: "VIRASAT KE SAATH VIKAS"

- **Round 1: Walk + Introduction (60 seconds)** – Judged on confidence, body language, etiquette, and personality.
- **Round 2: Talent Show (90 seconds)** – Participants perform any special skill.
- **Round 3: Q&A** – Judges test intelligence, wit, and quick thinking.
- **Elimination after each round.**
- **Judging criteria:** Confidence, stage presence, grooming, adherence to theme, creativity.
- Top five participants of the previous Modeling Kaunthing (2024) competition will not be eligible to participate this year.

Salsa Dance – 3 min

1. Pairs can be of any gender combination.
2. In same-gender pairs, one participant can take the role of the opposite gender.
3. Lifts and acrobatics are allowed but must be performed safely.
4. No inappropriate movements or excessive intimacy.
5. Pre-recorded music must be submitted in advance.
6. Costumes should be decent and elegant.

Battle of Bands – 7 Minutes

1. Each band must have **2 to 6 members**.
2. **Total performance time is 7 minutes, including setup.**
3. **The performance can be of any theme or genre.**
4. **Use of explicit lyrics or political themes is strictly prohibited.**
5. Judging will be based on **musical arrangement, stage presence, audience interaction, and originality.**

Meme Battle – 2 Minutes

1. Participants must submit original memes **in video format** prior to the event.
2. Each participant will have a maximum of **2 minutes** to present.
3. **Memes must be theme-independent** and adhere to clean humor—**no offensive, political, or derogatory content.**
4. **Videos must be free from slang, offensive language, or inappropriate edits.**
5. **All submitted meme videos will be reviewed and selected by the audition committee.** Only the approved version will be presented at the event—**no further modifications will be allowed.**
6. **The meme battle must stay true to the concept of memes; it should not turn into a stand-up comedy act or any other humorous performance. Additionally, no university or institution should be depicted in the memes.**
7. Judging will be based on humor, creativity, relevance, audience response, and adherence to guidelines.

Mime Act 5 min

1. Each team must have at least **3 members** and perform a **non-verbal** act using only body language and expressions.
2. No dialogues, lip-syncing, props, or background music are allowed; the act should rely solely on gestures and movement.
3. Performances must be **original**, within a **5-7 minute** limit, and any extra time will lead to negative marking.
4. Any content that is **offensive, obscene, or disrespectful** will result in **immediate disqualification**.
5. Teams must maintain decorum and ensure no damage to stage property during their act.
6. The decision of the judges will be **final and binding**.
7. Participants must report to the venue **30 minutes** before their scheduled performance time.

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
