The advantages of solar power car discussed are as follows:

- It is Eco-friendly and quiet
- Immense availability of energy
- No fuel costs
- Can run faster with comfort driving

The Chassis of the cart is 8ft long and the cost of the available project is 1.5 lakh rupees approximately. The passenger carrying capacity is 2.
