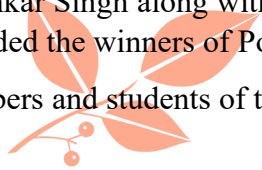

One day National Conference on Uniform Civil Code

On 2nd September 2023, a one-day national conference was organized on the topic “Uniform Civil Code: Discussion on constitutional efforts towards an egalitarian society” in the seminar hall of Chaman Lal Law College. Which was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Dr. Onkar Singh (Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Veer Madho Singh Bisht Technical University, Dehradun) and special guests retired Justice Murthy Shri Lokpal Singh (High Court Nainital), Ms. Aruna Bharti (SSP GRP Haridwar), Dr. Rajesh Dubey (Associate Professor, D.A.V.P.G. College, Dehradun) Dr. Ashok Kumar (Dean, Department of Law, Maa Shakambhari University, Saharanpur) Senior Advocate Mr. Bhoop Singh (Laxar) A.K. D.G. In this programme, all the guests presented

Justice Lokpal Singh expressed his views on the development of the society after the implementation of the Uniform Civil Code by highlighting the various statutory provisions of the Indian Constitution and the Hindu Marriage Act and Muslim law. In the same sequence, Ms. Arun Bharti SSP GRP, while expressing her views on this subject, said that under the Uniform Civil Code, everyone is likely to have equal rights and equal duties, which may reduce the number of crimes in the society. Expressing his views, senior advocate Bhup Singh expressed his support for the implementation of Uniform Civil Code by pointing out the difference related to extra-marital rights of Hindu and Muslim women.

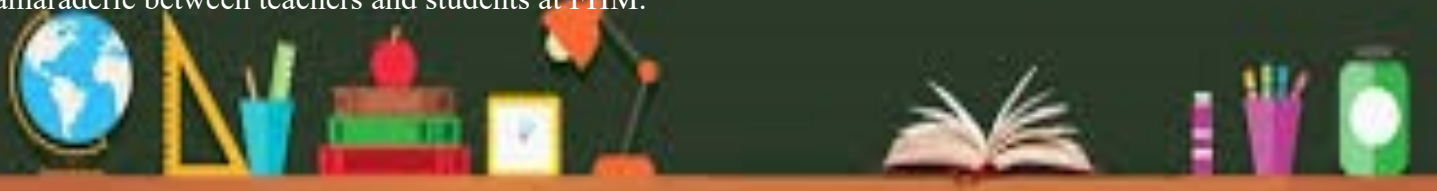

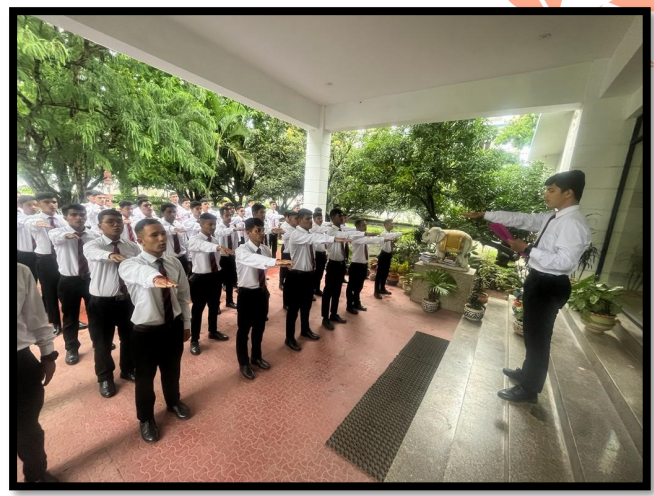
