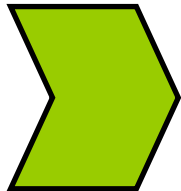

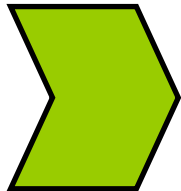


NUKKAD NATAK

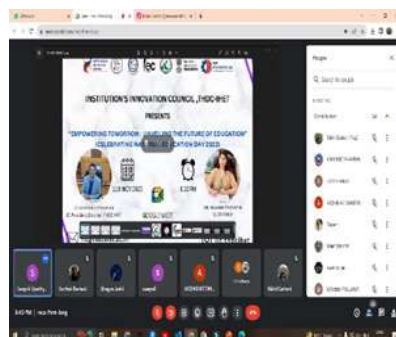

Entrepreneurial Voyage- Mapping Success Stories

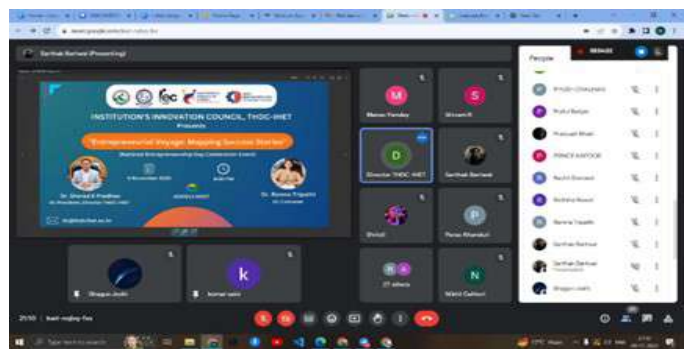

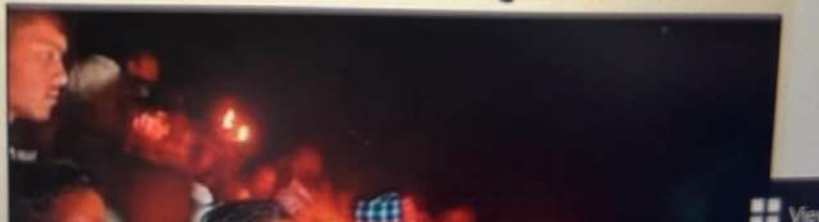
नए निदेशक डॉ. मंडोरिया ने कार्यभार संभाला

जागरण संवाददाता, देहरादून : उत्तराखण्ड के सभी इंजीनियरिंग कालेजों के छात्र-छात्राओं को चारों साल अनिवार्य रूप से औद्योगिक प्रशिक्षण लेना होगा। एआईसीटीई (आल इंडिया काउंसिल फॉर टेक्निकल एजुकेशन) ने उद्योगिता को बढ़ावा देने व पढ़ाई के बाद सीधे प्लेसमेंट का मौका देने को आधुनिक पाठ्यक्रम (करिकुलम) बनाया है। इस व्यवस्था को वीर माधो सिंह भंडारी उत्तराखण्ड प्रौद्योगिकी विश्वविद्यालय (यूटीयू) ने चालू सत्र से लागू कर दिया है। इंजीनियरिंग के छात्रों को द्वितीय, चतुर्थ, छठे और आठवें सेमेस्टर में अनिवार्य रूप से यह प्रशिक्षण लेना होगा। यूटीयू ने दूसरे सेमेस्टर से प्रशिक्षण की तैयारियां शुरू कर दी हैं।

एआईसीटीई के माडल करिकुलम में औद्योगिक प्रशिक्षण (इंडस्ट्रियल ट्रेनिंग) अनिवार्य है। उत्तराखण्ड के सभी इंजीनियरिंग कालेजों को दूसरे, चौथे, छठे व आठवें सेमेस्टर में यह ट्रेनिंग अनिवार्य रूप से करवाने को लेकर निर्देशित किया जा चुका है। औद्योगिक प्रशिक्षण के लिए उत्तराखण्ड के उद्योग एसोसिएशन के साथ पूर्व में यूटीयू का एमओयू हो चुका है।
