Veer Madho Singh Bhandari Uttarakhand Technical University, Dehradun was established on 27th January 2005 by Govt. of Uttarakhand through the Uttarakhand Technical University Act 2005. The Veer Madho Singh Bhandari Uttarakhand Technical University campus is situated at NH-72 Suddhowala, Dehradun. Dehradun is the capital of Uttarakhand State and is well connected through Rail, Road and Air transport.

The University has been established in an area of 8.372 hectare and it is the only affiliating University of the state for technical institutions. There are 81 Affiliated Private Institutions and 12 Government Institutions in the University. University is running 8 UG, 6 PG and 18 Ph.D. programmes with approximately twenty thousand students in various courses.

- 1. Leadership Excellence (Monday, 24 April, 2023)** - In this interactive session Dr. Vora will discuss Leadership Excellence. You will learn various leadership characteristics. Difference between a manager and leader will be explored. You will examine your own leadership characteristics. Excellent leadership models will be discussed. He will sketch out a roadmap for leadership excellence and development. You will learn key concepts, best practices, and practical tools to enhance your leadership excellence.
- 2. Effective Decision Making (Thursday, 27 April, 2023)** - In this interactive session Dr. Vora will discuss Effective Decision Making. People make decisions all the time. The quality of those decisions is often in question - even by those who make them. Participants will be provided with both background knowledge and practical models to prioritize and make decisions that will allow individual or an organization to fulfill their vision, mission, objectives, and goals.
- 3. Effective Time Management (Monday, 01 May, 2023)** - In this interactive session Dr. Vora will discuss Effective Time Management. You will learn various aspects of effective time management strategies such as goal setting, planning, prioritizing, scheduling, and organizing. You will learn key concepts, best practices, and practical tips to enhance your time management skills to be effective and efficient.
- 4. Effective Teamwork (Wednesday, 03 May, 2023)** - In this interactive session Dr. Vora will discuss Effective Teamwork. You will learn importance of teamwork to accomplish various initiatives in any organization. Five dysfunctions of a team will be shared. Also, goal setting and prioritizing will be addressed to enhance your teamwork performance.
- 5. Effective Project Management (Monday, 08 May, 2023)** - In this interactive session Dr. Vora will discuss Effective Project Management (PM), a necessary skill for all professionals. The PM skills are critical in deploying strategic initiatives, managing capital projects, managing change, and executing continuous improvement initiatives. Unfortunately, only 25-30% of projects succeed globally. You will be able to manage projects with better outcomes.
- 6. Career Development Guidance (Wednesday, 10 May, 2023)** - In this interactive session, Dr Vora will provide tips on career development. His success formula includes four pillars (Planning, Strengths, Soft Skills, and Community Service). He will address: 1) Importance of Planning and Execution, 2) Understanding one's Strengths and leveraging them, 3) Critical Skills needed to succeed in the 21st Century such as communication, leadership, decision making, teamwork, time management, problem solving, project management, and change management, and 4) Importance of giving back to the society for Nation Building.

He received 40 awards/honors for his life-long community service including U. S. President's Volunteer Service Award. In March 2022, he was recognized for his Social Work in Education and Healthcare by the World Book of Records, UK. Tata Scholarship in India to pursue his graduate work in the US.
